Sacraments

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM - Baptisms are celebrated every Sunday at 12:15pm. Parents are expected to attend a Pre-Jordan Baptism class. Please call the Rectory to register for a class so that we have adequate materials. Godparents and children are welcome to attend.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE - In order to accommodate our own Parishioners, only Parishioners of St. Peter (Bride or Groom) will be able to be married in St. Peter Church. Couples planning to marry at St. Peter are expected to contact the priest to arrange a date and time first. Second, they must attend the Pre-Cana Conferences as mandated by the Bishop. The period of preparation for marriage is a minimum of six months to ensure completion of all arrangements before the wedding date. For Pre-Cana reservations call 663-1373. Only Parish Musicians are permitted for Wedding Masses. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK - The priests may be called at any time day or night for the Sacrament of the Sick. Furthermore, the priests will be happy to visit the Sick with Holy Communion upon request.

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION - (Confessions) Saturday from 4:00-4:55pm and 7:00-7:30 pm or contact one of the priests.

FUNERALS - The proper form of Church burial for a baptized Catholic is the Mass of Christian Burial, not a service at a funeral home. Viewings in the Church are not permitted. Funeral Masses are scheduled at 10:00am. No eulogies in church, and only Parish Musicians are permitted for Funeral Masses, **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Our Seminarian To Be Ordained a Deacon June 13, 2020



We are overjoyed to announce that our parishioner, Carlo Santa Teresa, will be ordained a transitional deacon on June 13 of this year! He recently received the official date, originally planned for May 16, but was rescheduled due to the Coronavirus.

Carlo Santa Teresa was born in Voorhees, NJ on September 14, 1989, the only child of Josefina Santa Teresa. Raised in Cherry Hill, he attended St. Peter Celestine Catholic School in Cherry Hill and graduated from Camden Catholic High School in 2007. He began formation for the priesthood for the Diocese of Camden in 2013 and graduated from the College Seminary of the Immaculate Conception – St. Andrew’s Hall at Seton Hall University in 2016. In the summer of 2017, he studied Ignatian Spirituality at the Institute of Priestly Formation (IPF) at Creighton University in Omaha, NE. He is currently studying at Immaculate Conception Seminary in South Orange, NJ pursuing a Masters in Divinity as well as a Master of the Arts in Ecclesiastical History. He has also served as seminary historian from 2017 to 2018.

In 2018, he was assigned to a pastoral year and was stationed at St. Andrew the Apostle Roman Catholic Church in Gibbsboro, NJ.

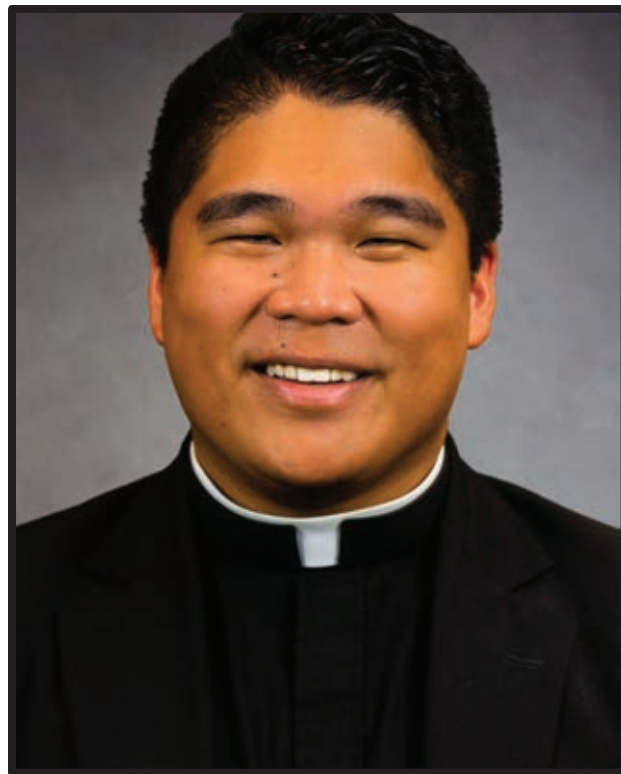
A parishioner of St. Peter’s since 2006, Carlo has been active at the parish as an altar server, a member of the parish Pro-Life Apostolate and Young Adult Ministry and is a member of St. Peter’s Knights of Columbus Council 6735. He is also a member of the Knights of Peter Claver and the International Order of Alhambra and from 2008 to 2013 he served on the Marian Commission of the Diocese of Camden.

We are immensely proud of Carlo. This is his last step before priestly ordination. Soon enough he will be celebrating his first Mass at St. Peter’s.

Reading I – Acts of the Apostles 6:1-7

As the number of disciples continued to grow, the Hellenists complained against the Hebrews because their widows were being neglected in the daily distribution. So the Twelve called together the community of the disciples and said, “It is not right for us to neglect the word of God to serve at table. Brothers, select from among you seven reputable men, filled with the Spirit and wisdom, whom we shall appoint to this task, whereas we shall devote ourselves to prayer and to the ministry of the word.” The proposal was acceptable to the whole community, so they chose Stephen, a man filled with faith and the Holy Spirit, also Philip, Prochorus, Nicanor, Timon, Parmenas, and Nicholas of Antioch, a convert to Judaism. They presented these men to the apostles who prayed and laid hands on them. The word of God continued to spread, and the number of the disciples in Jerusalem increased greatly; even a large group of priests were becoming obedient to the faith.

If there were not, would I have told you that I am going to prepare a place for you? And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back again and take you to myself, so that where I am you also may be. Where I am going you know the way.” Thomas said to him, “Master, we do not know where you are going; how can we know the way?” Jesus said to him, I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. If you know me, then you will also know my Father. From now on you do know him and have seen him.” Philip said to him, “Master, show us the Father, and that will be enough for us.” Jesus said to him, “Have I been with you for so long a time and you still do not know me, Philip? Whoever has seen me has seen the Father. How can you say, ‘Show us the Father’? Do you not believe that I am in the Father and the Father is in me? The words that I speak to you I do not speak on my own. The Father who dwells in me is doing his works.
