
Our Family

GRADE 8

THE SPIRITUAL WORKS OF MERCY

Admonish the sinner, Instruct the ignorant, Counsel the doubtful Comfort the sorrowful, Bear wrongs patiently, Forgive all injuries and Pray for the living and the dead

THE CORPORAL WORKS OF MERCY

Feed the hungry, Give drink to the thirsty, Clothe the naked, Visit the imprisoned, Shelter the homeless, Visit the sick, and Bury the dead

THE NICENE CREED

I believe in one God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible.

GRADE 7

DEFINITION OF A SACRAMENT

A Sacrament is an outward sign, instituted by Christ, to give grace.

THE 7 SACRAMENTS: The 7 Sacraments are Baptism, Penance, Holy Eucharist, Confirmation, Matrimony, Holy Orders, the Anointing of the Sick

THE 7 GIFTS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

Wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety, and fear of God.

THE 12 FRUITS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

GRADE 4

THE MORNING OFFERING

O Jesus, through the Immaculate Heart of Mary, I offer Thee my prayers, works, joys and sufferings of this day in union with the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass throughout the world. I offer them for all the intentions of Thy Sacred Heart: the salvation of souls, reparation for sin, the reunion of all Christians. I offer them for the intentions of our Bishops and of all the Apostles of Prayer, and in particular for those recommended by our Holy Father for this month. Amen.
